## Our Commitment to Your Privacy

## How We May Use and Disclose Your Information

**Treatment:** We may use and disclose your health information to provide, coordinate, or manage your healthcare.

**Payment:** We may use and disclose your health information to obtain payment for services provided.

**Healthcare Operations:** We may use and disclose your health information for administrative and operational purposes, including quality improvement and compliance.

## Uses Required by Law

We may disclose your information when required by federal or North Carolina law, including public health reporting, legal proceedings, law enforcement requests, and workers' compensation claims.

## Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Access and obtain a copy of your records
- Request corrections to your records
- Request restrictions on disclosures
- Request confidential communications
- Receive a copy of this notice
